#### What We're Looking For:

Innovative project ideas addressing Nepal's development, sustainability, and social challenges. Projects should demonstrate creativity, impact potential, and alignment with Nepal's needs.

#### Eligibility:

- Young Fulbright alumni under 40 years – Alumni of Fulbright Foreign Student Program, Humphrey Fellowship Program, Fulbright Teaching Excellence and Achievement Program (Fulbright TEA) and Global Undergraduate Exchange Program (Global UGRAD Program) are eligible to participate.
- Residing in Nepal and committed to contributing to the country's progress.
- Projects must be implementable within Nepal.
- The theme of your project can be of your choice, but it should contribute to addressing key issues in Nepal.

#### Why Participate?

- Compete for prize funding to bring your project to life.
- Showcase your idea to a panel of experts and peers.
- Strengthen connections within the Fulbright alumni network.
- All participants will receive a certificate of recognition from FAAN

#### How to Apply:

#### Selection Process:

Shortlisted finalists will be contacted via email and called to present their ideas to a judging panel on event day. Innovative ideas are selected based on project merit, diversity, innovative and creativity, impact potential and sustainability.
